#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Beanies and entries must be RECEIVED before Friday May 26th 2017. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED COD.

#### **Categories**

#### 1 Magical Worlds Prize

For a beanie incorporating a magical creature, person or place. Ghosts, gollums, faeries, sphinxes and monsters from any tradition are welcome.

#### 2 A Magical Beanie

Design a beanie for a magical person or creature: a forest crown, a battle headdress, protective gear for a dragon-rider, or a thinking cap for a wise owl. Feel free to create your own creature or character.

#### 3 Campfire Yarns Beanie

Remember a story that gave you sweet dreams or nightmares? This prize is for a beanie about story telling. Celebrate the storyteller. Or create something from a story or a poem that entered your imagination and never left.

#### **4 Creature Feature Beanie**

A beanie celebrating birds, animals, sea-life, insects or invertebrates.

#### 5 Spirit of the Land

A beanie celebrating our desert, forest, coast, bush and urban or magical landscapes.

#### **6 Heart Felt Prize**

Celebrating felting: Including wet felting, nuno-felting, needle felting or knit and felt techniques at the festival.

#### 7 Embellishment Prize

A prize for a piece that uses beads or seeds, feathers, tjanpi, embroidery, stitching or other embellishment to create a remarkable piece of work.

#### **8 Committee Acquisition Prize**

A prize for wonderful and unusual piece of work. These works are acquired forour collection.

### 9 The Eileen Bladon Tea-Cosy Prize

Celebrating the tea cosie, as a sister object to the beanie.

#### 10 Children's Prize

A prize for a beanie maker under 12 years who has created a masterpiece, according to their age and skill level.

#### 11 New Wave Prize

A prize for a beanie maker 12-19 years of age, who has shown skill and thought in their work. Celebrating a bit of zaniness. For a beanie that invites interaction and fun.

#### 12 Central Australian Prize

A prize for a magnificent work made by an artist from Central Australia and surrounding communities.

#### 13 The Mad Cap Prize

Celebrating a bit of zaniness. For a beanie that invites interaction and fun.

#### 14 People's Choice Prize

The favourite beanie of 2017, as voted by festival goers..

No fascinators or string hats will be exhibited in 2017. Our beanie definition includes any hat that provides some warmth.

<u>NOTE:</u> All beanies will be judged in all categories. Everyone can have a go at entering a beanie – not just designers!

### **Weaving the Magic: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1) All entries must have arrived by last mail 26 May 2017. No discussion will be entered into. No extensions possible.
- 2) Each competitor may enter <u>two</u> pieces into the competition. <u>The First entry must be for sale, the second</u> can be for sale or not for sale.
- 3) **Sales:** There is a tendency to underprice the work, so please consider all your costs materials, postage, entry fees, commission, effort etc.
- 4) Entries to be sent to: Alice Springs Beanie Festival, Araluen Arts Centre, PO Box 3521, Alice Springs NT 0871
- 5) Each entry must be delivered with:
- i) Entry fee: a non-refundable entry fee of \$20 per beanie/teacosy. Payment can be made by cheque or money order to the Alice Springs Beanie Festival. Cash payment may be made by hand delivery only. International entries payment must be made with an international bank cheque or Australian dollars.
- **ii) Receipts:** If you require a receipt, please request in writing with a stamped, self-addressed envelope
- iii) Identification Label: The artists name, address and price must be marked and firmly stitched (not pinned) to the inside crown of the beanie. Please use a cloth tag (you only need to do this for competition beanies).
- **iv) Beanie Festival Swingtag must** also be attached so that it hangs out of the beanie from the inside crown in an obvious way, with the price clearly written.
- v) Barcode We will attach a barcode to your entry as we receive it and note it on your entry form.
- vi) Entry Form: a completed and signed entry form.
- vii) Artists statement/Beanie Stories (optional): Please send an artist statement with your work in a one page A4 format. If your work is in a particular cultural/family tradition we

- would love to know the origins of your work, e.g. send a story about your work, a story about your making. This will be placed in an A4 folder within the exhibition space and possibly used in festival publications.
- 6) All entries will be seen by the judges.
- 7) Any entries that are not displayed within the Araluen Gallery will be displayed as part of the Beanie Central Exhibition.
- 8) <u>50</u>% commission will be taken from the asking price by the Araluen Galleries (40%) and the Beanie Festival (10%).
- 9) **Payment from sold work:** Payment for sold works will be made by cheque as soon as possible after the close of the exhibition (July 17th)
- 10) **International Entries:** Cheques will be sent in Australian dollars.
- 11) While all care will be taken with the entries, no responsibility will be accepted for lost or damaged items, by the Alice Springs Beanie Festival or the Araluen Arts Centre. Insurance remains the responsibility of the artist.
- 12) The Beanie Festival reserves the right to use images of the works entered free of charge for any promotion or publication. Apart from this, copy right resides with the entrant.
- 13) All entries must have been produced after 1 July 2016 and not previously exhibited.
- 14) **Unsold work:** All unsold work will be returned to the artist. Please note on the entry form how you would like your piece returned and include paperwork with entry fee if appropriate.
